Code of Conduct for parents/carers

It is the aim of the club to encourage the active participation of parents and carers of our junior members in the club's activities. We would ask all parents and carers to help us foster the right attitude to our sport by following these guidelines:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Please respect all Club Coaches and their decisions
- Please raise any concerns regarding Coaches, Officials, other members or parents with the Club Welfare Officer
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.

Most of all please remember that this is 'THEIR GAME' not ours and they ALL have a right to have fun regardless of the outcome.
